In Novemeber 2020 we were delighted to launch our new extended warranty package; E-Bound Care. Over 10% of our customers have already signed up for the peace of mind that this will bring.

As a small family-run business, we are always looking at ways to minimise risk for our customers. This includes unexpected financial outlay. We understand that having to pay for parts replacements for your roof alarm hardware can be a real setback. Our extended warranty will cover you for any replacements that are required due to mechanical faults.

Why should you sign up?

Nothing lasts forever, certainly not advanced technology in highly exposed weather conditions. The roof alarm systems in our church building portfolio can be up to twelve years old, and the natural degradation of materials over a prolonged period takes its toll. The technology we use is also finite by its very nature; you wouldn't expect your mobile telephone or satnay to last for decades, nor might you want it to when better systems become available. We are constantly researching and improving our technology and will make these product upgrades available to you when your hardware naturally needs replacing.



How much does it cost?

Not only are we extending our standard 12-month warranty for all roof alarms fitted after 1st November 2019 by a further year, we are offering all churches the option to purchase annual warranty cover for an annual fee of £195 per year for a minimum of 3 years. That's £0.53 a day for peace of mind.

We are changing the way we report alarms to you.

Over the next few weeks we are enhancing the way in which intruder and tamper activations are reported to you;

- In addition to the telephone call from the Alarm Receiving Centre, you will receive an email to your nominated email address or addresses.
- 2. This message will come from the following email address mezzaninefailed@smc-net.co.uk. (Please ensure this email address is added to your 'safe list').
- 3. This will replace any follow up email from E-Bound AVX Limited that you may have previously received.
- 4. In summary, you will receive a telephone call and an email advising you of the alarm activation.
 - a. In the event that you use Response Officers to attend alarm calls, you will still receive an email, but the telephone call will be made to the Response Officers instead.
 - **b.** Following a visit from a Response Officer, a visit report is generated. (As our offices will be closed for the Christmas holiday, any reports will be sent in January when we return).



Our contract with you

Your alarm and the care and security of your church is your responsibility. In the event of an activation it is the responsibility of the nominated the responsibility of the nominated personnel at the church to respond to this information appropriately and safely. You should ensure, as soon as possible that the church remains secure and report anything suspicious to the police. Should you wish to speak with us regarding the alarm please call 01733 843341.Our office hours are 08:00 to 18:00. Outside of office hours this number remains active but is a 24 hour reporting facility and your query will be responded to based on urgency. Please note that any urgent calls after 20:00hrs may be responded to the next day. You should ensure that you have arrangements in place so that if your alarm does go off everyone tasked with responding to it knows what to do. This includes how you will check to see what has happened who will call the police if necessary. These arrangements must work 24 hours a day. You should also amend any current risk assessments to take account of these changes.

E-Bound are now officially approved by Secured by Design

Secured by Design is an official Police security initiative with the aim to reduce crime through design and other approaches to reduce the demand on Police forces. Since 1989 Secured by Design have had more than one million homes built to SBD standards, reduced overall property crime by 60%, worked with Police forces to reduce the number of false alarm calls to Police from 1,05,538 in 1996 to 124,164 in 2017.

This is a proud moment for everyone here at E-Bound as it allows us to work directly with Police from now on which will help in our efforts to prevent lead theft and to assist local authorities in the apprehension of thieves any way we can.

At E-Bound we take pride in our technology and for it to be recognised by the Police as secure and reliable alarm technology pushes us to new heights, we will always be looking to improve our alarm technology to become even more accurate, reliable and secure. Our aim ultimately is to eradicate lead theft and with the support of the Police the closer that goal becomes.
